2022 Conference Recap


Breakout Review by Rachel Sanders

Betty F. Walker, a former Administrative Assistant at First Baptist Church, Burlington, was the founder and first president of the North Carolina Baptist Secretaries Association. She served on the Planning Committee that led to the formation of the National Association of Southern Baptist Secretaries and served as the second President of that organization. Betty was a teacher and trainer for Baptist secretaries for many years.

Betty, along with others, dreamed of a professional organization for Baptist secretaries for many years. Following the birth of the state and national organizations, Betty gave much of her life to these organizations.

The North Carolina Baptist Secretaries Association exists because of the dream and vision of Betty Walker. Through this endowment fund, which bears her name, that dream will be realized.
